You're invited to join our weekly explorations in Art & Clay, here at the historic *"El Rancho de Cabeza de Baca"*. We'll work with the time-honored pinch, coil and slab methods; process the rich red clay found here onsite, burnish to a deep shine, and fire outside with sawdust for a rich black finish. The pottery traditions of the Keresan pueblo (ancestral to our neighbors at Cochiti and Santo Domingo) in nearby La Cieneguilla, c. 1300-1600 inform our work. We will also introduce ourselves to the black and white painted-pottery traditions found all over the ancient Southwest, and, using "paint-your-own", ready-made bisque, learn from this 1000-year old New Mexican artist-potters.
